

Directions to Camp Alexander

Camp Alexander sits inside beautiful Eleven Mile Canyon along the South Platte River about 1 hour west of Colorado Springs, CO.

From Colorado Springs

- Take Highway 24 west to the town of Lake George. Entering the town of Lake George, take the first left onto County Road 96.
 - Look for 'Granite Canyon General Store' and turn South (left) just before the store. (If you cross the river, you have gone too far)
- Follow County Road 96 (about 1 mile) to the 11-Mile Canyon Entrance.
- Turn right into 11-Mile Canyon and proceed to the Forest Ranger Station. Tell the gate attendant that you are heading to Camp Alexander, as entry fee is free if you are going to camp.
 - Note: If you intend to travel on the canyon road beyond the Camp Entrance or explore any part of the canyon you must pay the entry fee at the gate station.
- Follow 11-Mile Canyon past Riverside Campground about 2 miles (watch for oncoming traffic and keep speed low).
- Look for the Camp Entrance on the left.
- Enter through the gateway and turn right at the first intersection (you will see houses on the left these are private residences, please do not stop there).
- Continue down the camp road passing our main parking lot and continue into the main camp.
- You will pass the Ice Climbing wall; the pool and you can park in the parking lot near our camp office.
- Meet your climbing guide near the ice climbing wall at your scheduled time.
- If you are camping for the weekend you can check in via the radio near the camp office.
